Applications submitted must include the following items in the order listed below:

1. Fully completed / legible applications (all 3 pages) with a professional photograph of the applicant.
2. A copy of the applicant's official high school transcripts, all pages (minimum 2.8 GPA)
3. **Applicant must attend an HBCU and or plan to Major in Education.**
4. Three signed/Dated Letters of recommendation from your academic community.
5. Completed, signed, and dated document of community service activities form. Please make additional copies of the Community Service Activities form as needed.
6. The applicant is to submit a one-page narrative describing his/her future ambitions.
7. Applicant to complete a one-page Essay on George Miller's background via the applicant's independent research of his impact on politics in Union County.
8. Please provide your email address, and phone number on the Application. Applicants are to include this checklist in the scholarship application package.

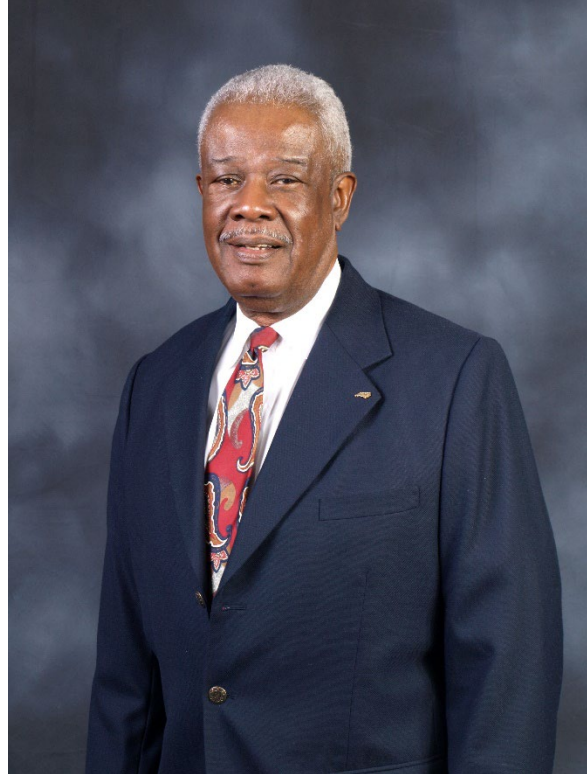
PLEASE NOTE

Only fully completed application packages are eligible. One original package along with two (2) identical copy packages must be received by the scholarship sponsors no later than April 1, 2026, at 5:00 pm (applicants are allowed to open sealed envelopes with transcripts and letters of recommendation for purposes of copying packages). Timely receipt of your fully documented package is the student applicant's responsibility.

A native of Monroe North Carolina, George Lee Miller was born on October 26, 1940, to Nathan Alfred Miller and Theao Covington Miller.

Although, his parents weren't formally educated, education was a foundational part of what was preached to him from an early age. Lee, as he was intimately known, graduated from Winchester High School in Monroe, NC in 1958. He continued his formal education and enrolled in Livingstone College in Salisbury, North Carolina. While focusing on his studies he became



an active member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. In 1962 he graduated from Livingstone College with a Bachelor of Arts Degree. He continued his educational endeavors and received his Master of Science in Education-Administration Degree from North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University and a Certificate of Graduate Study in Education from University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. With a love for learning and impacting the community Lee became a teacher. He taught social studies for 3 years at

East Union Middle School. Striving to impact the community more, Lee became the principal of Indian Trail Elementary School, and was there for 27 years until his retirement. He was the first black principal in the school's history.

Lee also allowed his gifts to impact both Anson and Union County. He joined Black's Memorial Presbyterian Church at an early age and served in many capacities. On weekends Lee would spend time educating inmates in the Anson County prison system. He also served the city of Monroe in various capacities. Some of them included serving on the Union County Planning Board, Union County Housing Authority and NC State Employees Credit Union Advisory Board. His community activities included Winchester Community Association, Winchester Alumni Association and Optimist Club. He was also an active and faithful member of A Few Good Men, Inc.

Lee lived a fruitful life. From playing poker with friends to watching "Dem Boys" (Dallas Cowboys), he was always ready for tasty food, a good laugh and friendly competition. He also loved spending time outside on his lawn mower and in the woods hunting rabbits with the boys.

Lee's purposeful life ended on October 6, 2018
